

Science and engineering firm SynTerra acquires Duncklee & Dunham

SynTerra Corporation, a science and engineering firm, announced that it has acquired Duncklee & Dunham of Cary, NC. The acquisition gives SynTerra its ninth office across five Southeastern states and increases the company's staff size to more than 180.
